<u>Sunny Weather</u>



During the summer months can parents please ensure children have a (named) hat to wear at playtimes? Reception class and Nursery children play and work outside throughout the day, so a sun hat is essential. Most sun creams are effective for up to 3 hours and some last all day. Therefore, can sun cream be applied at home and if necessary sent in children's bags for them to apply again themselves at lunch time.

Staff will supervise children but are not permitted to apply any non-prescribed creams.

Waterproof Coat

Please ensure your child has a waterproof coat in school at all times.

After the assembly they will be invited into the classroom to look at the children's work between 9.15 and 10am. Siblings are welcome; however, if they become restless please can you take them into the library in order to avoid the class losing their concentration. Thank you.

<u>Water Bottles</u>

If your child loses his/her water bottle we can supply another one for $\pounds 1$. Please see Mrs Colwell in the office. Children <u>must</u> bring their water bottle to school particularly this term as there will hopefully be some warm days. Research shows that children's concentration improves when they drink water as well as the obvious benefits of being well hydrated.

PE Kits

Please can parents ensure all children have a named PE kit, including plimsolls that fit correctly in school every day? Can those children who use their PE kits for football club and then go home wearing them, please bring them back to school on Monday morning?

Punctuality

If your child arrives late please can you ensure a member of staff knows he/she has arrived? Thank you.

<u>Attendance</u>

Thank you to all parents for ensuring children are not unnecessarily off school or arriving late. It is vitally important that children arrive for school on time and are ready to commence their activities. Lateness can cause disruption to the class and can make the child feel unsettled. It may also mean that the important teacher input part of a lesson is missed resulting in children being unclear of what they are being asked to do.

It is also important that Nursery children learn about arriving for school on time and get used to the routine of school and nursery life. Late arrivals in Nursery are unsettling for the other children.

If you need to remove your child from school for extended holidays, we ask that permission is granted prior to the event. Requests for more than 2 weeks of absence within a school year will in future be discussed by the governing body of the school. Additional absence from school can result in gaps in children's knowledge, so we ask that you seriously consider this before taking additional holidays. Thank you for your support with this matter.

Students visiting school

During week commencing 13th June we welcome two Hong Kong students. They will be spending the week in Nursery. Their visit is planned by Durham University as part of their B Ed English Language Immersion Programme. The students are training to be Early Years Teachers in Hong Kong.

National Sports week

Events will be held in school during Week commencing 27th June to celebrate the forthcoming Olympic Games. Further details will follow from Mr Handy. This will also be a time to celebrate Olympic values and will include events surrounding a celebration of all of the countries in the world represented in this school.



Transition sessions

This will give a valuable insight into how the teacher may be able to capitalise on the information in order to enrich your child's educational experience within this school.
