Children of all year groups are welcome to come to any of the book fair days with their parent or other carer. Please also note that it will be possible to browse and purchase books if you are collecting from Sunshine Club after 4pm. There will be a selection of books suitable for older children who come from St Margaret's. Purchases can be made using cash, cheque (payable to St Oswald's School Fund) or debit/credit card.

If you are unable to come to the fair with your child, you can still order a book by completing the pre-order form at the back of the leaflet. Please send the form along with cash or cheque (payable to St Oswald's School Fund) to the school office in a clearly labelled envelope. Book orders must be delivered to the school office by 3pm on Thursday 14th March. Children will be given the books to take home if they are in stock at our fair. Out of stock books will be delivered to school on Monday 18th March.
