

## Reception Curriculum Overview 2020/21

This is an outline of what your child will be learning this year. There will be daily phonics, reading, writing and maths sessions which will be taught through various exciting topics and themes. As well as this, your child will have chance to play both indoors and outdoors, in the role play, construction, reading and craft areas. As we are a voluntary aided school, religious education (RE) is outlined here and will be taught separately from the topic. In addition to this, personal, social, health education (PSHE) is outlined, as well as physical education (PE). Every Friday, you will receive a weekly update (via Parentmail) which will have a detailed outline of what your child has learnt that week, in all subject areas, as well as providing you with any additional information or reminders.
